INTERCHANGE 145 IMPROVEMENTS

• CENTRAL AVE • ORATON PARKWAY
• BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION - MP 144 TO MP 152



Over the past several months the New Jersey Turnpike Authority has been performing utility related work on Central Avenue and temporary exit ramp construction on Oraton Parkway in preparation for Central Avenue Bridge replacement. In mid-November 2018, the southbound Garden State Parkway temporary Exit Ramp to Oraton Parkway and CCR 508 will open and a new work zone and traffic pattern will be created on the Central Avenue Bridge over the Garden State Parkway. The temporary Exit Ramp will enable motorists to follow an alternate route to Central Avenue (CR 508) eastbound. The new work zone on the Central Avenue Bridge will eliminate several existing traffic movements at the intersections of SB South Oraton Parkway/Whittlesey Avenue and Birchwood Avenue/NB South Oraton Parkway during bridge construction. Traffic detours will be available and clearly marked showing alternate traffic routes to guide motorists through the area.
